

GETTING TO LIVORNO

By air



The nearest major airport is Galileo Galilei International Airport of Pisa (PSA / LIRP). Direct flights connect Galileo Galilei International Airport to several Italian cities and numerous international destinations.

The airport is approximately 27 km from Livorno city centre that can be easily reached in ca. 15 minutes by train.

An automated peplemover links Galileo Galilei International Airport with Pisa Centrale railway station (PisaMover). The PisaMover stop is located just outside the airport.

From Pisa Centrale railway station trains run more or less every 10-15 minutes to Livorno Centrale railway station.

Another major airport is Florence Airport, Peretola (FLR / LIRQ), which is 89 km from Livorno. From this airport to Firenze Santa Maria Novella railway station there is a shuttle bus. From Firenze Santa Maria Novella railway station You can reach Livorno by train in ca. 1h15.

By train



“Livorno Centrale” station is one of the main regional railway stations.

Frequent trains run to Pisa, Florence and Rome.

The station is at the eastern edge of the city centre, around 5 kilometers from the congress venue. The taxi rank and the bus stop for urban routes can be found outside the railway terminal.

By car



Livorno can be easily reached also by car through the FI-PI-LI highway (from Florence or Pisa), the A12 motorway or the state highway 1 Aurelia (from Rome or Genoa).

Most of the historical centre of Livorno is a Limited Traffic Zone (ZTL), so only authorised vehicles can access this zone (unauthorised access will be fined). The congress venue is not situated in a Limited Traffic Zone.
